

## 2008 external examination – markers for written papers

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The Curriculum Council seeks expressions of interest from teachers and other qualified people who wish to be considered for appointment as markers for the written papers in the 2008 external examinations for Applied Information Technology, Aviation, Earth and Environmental Science, Engineering Studies, English, English as an Additional Language/Dialect, Media Production and Analysis and Physical Education Studies.

The written component of the external examinations starts on Monday, 3 November 2008 and finishes on Friday, 21 November 2008. If selected as a marker, you would need to be available from the date of the examination for about four weeks (exact dates will be advised in the letter of appointment).

Marking involves about 35 hours/week of evening and weekend work, from the date of the relevant external examination. This includes compulsory markers' meetings to standardise the marking procedure and to resolve discrepancies between markers.

Markers are paid a fee for their work. Details about fees paid can be obtained from the Curriculum Council.

Application for selection as a marker does not guarantee appointment. Applicants will be advised whether they have been selected no later than mid-September 2008.
