

## **2008 external examinations – practical components (Drama Studies, Aviation, Music and Physical Education Studies)**

The practical components of the 2008 external examinations in Drama Studies, Aviation, Music and Physical Education Studies will be held in the Term 3 school holidays (Tuesday, 30 September – Friday, 10 October 2008).

Candidates will be advised through schools in September of the specific time and location of their examinations.

Teachers should inform students of these arrangements as soon as possible.

### **Specific arrangements for Drama Studies**

#### **Metropolitan candidates**

There will be two metropolitan examination venues, as in previous years, and the timetable will be based on the following:

- first week of holiday: Government schools
- second week of holiday: non-Government schools

#### **Country candidates**

Examination centres will be established in major country locations. Schools will be contacted later in the year regarding arrangements. It should be noted that the examinations may be scheduled for any time during the two-week period.

Candidates from other country locations will travel to Perth for the practical examination, and will be scheduled in the metropolitan timetable on their preferred date. Schools will be contacted early in Term 3 regarding these arrangements.

### **Specific arrangements for Physical Education Studies**

Metropolitan venues will be established for each of the 14 sports to be examined and in major country locations, where possible. Selected schools will be contacted later in the year regarding arrangements.

Candidates from other country locations will travel to Perth for the practical examination, and will be scheduled in the metropolitan timetable. Schools will be contacted early in Term 3 regarding these arrangements.

It should be noted that the examinations may be scheduled for any time during the two-week period. Candidates will be advised through schools in September of the specific time and location of their examinations.

### **Specific arrangements for Music**

As well as metropolitan venue/s, examination centres will be established in major country locations. Schools will be contacted later in the year regarding arrangements.

It should be noted that the examinations may be scheduled for any time during the two-week period. Candidates will be advised through schools in September of the specific time and location of their examinations.

### **Specific arrangements for Aviation**

It is anticipated that the practical examinations for Aviation will be held in the metropolitan area over three days in the second week of the holidays, Wednesday 8 October – Friday 10 October. Examinations may be held in country locations if there are sufficient numbers of candidates. Where country examination centres are not established, candidates will travel to Perth for their examinations.
