Schools are reminded that students may appeal against their school assessments. Students should be made aware of the assessment review procedures within the school and provide students with the opportunity to resolve any issues that might arise. If a student is not satisfied with the school's response to a formal request for an assessment review they may appeal to the Curriculum Council.

The form that is used by students appealing to the Curriculum Council is provided in Section 7.11 of the WACE Procedures Manual or online at http://www.curriculum.wa.edu.au/internet/Communications/Publications/WACE_Procedures. The closing dates for appeals to be received at the Curriculum Council are:

14 November 2008 for E-code subjects and WACE courses studied in Year 12

12 December 2008 for D-code subjects and WACE courses studies in Year 11.

Assessment reviews and appeals are intended to determine whether:

- the school's assessment procedures conform with its assessment policy and to Curriculum Council guidelines
- the school's assessment outline conforms with Curriculum Council requirements
- there are any procedural or computational errors in the determination of the numerical school assessment and/or grade.
