Physical Education Studies teachers are requested to remind students about equipment and clothing for the practical examination.

As per the 'Candidate notes: 2008 Physical Education Studies practical examination' issued to all examination candidates, they are reminded of the following:

### What to bring and wear

- You must bring your signed practical examination advice.
- You are required to wear clothing and use equipment that is approved for use by your sport's governing body.
- Your clothing and equipment must not identify you (by name) or your school or teacher or club or team representation in any way.
- You are requested to wear a black, white or navy shirt if possible.
- All personal playing and safety equipment (eg sticks, racquets, bats, gloves, shin pads, mouth guards, footwear) must be supplied by the candidate.
- Water will be available but you must bring your own water bottle.
- You are responsible for the security of your own belongings. You are advised not to bring valuables.

### Equipment provided

- Non-personal items such as netballs and shuttles will be provided.
- Change facilities will be available at all venues.
- Refreshments (other than water) will not be available at most venues.
