Students who have been prevented from attending an examination, or whose performance has been affected by a temporary sickness, non-permanent disability or unforeseen misadventure suffered immediately before or during the examination period, may wish to submit a sickness/misadventure application. The circumstances must be beyond the usual control of the student.

Students are encouraged to submit their application immediately following their last written examination. Applications relating to incidents during practical examinations should have already been submitted. The completed form and any supporting documentation must be received by the Curriculum Council no later than 5pm on Tuesday 25 November 2008.

Candidates will be informed of the outcome of their application at the same time as they receive their statement of results.
