The WACE Manual 2009 states that:

- Students can only sit one examination in a course as the Stage 2 and Stage 3 examinations for a course are held at the same time. (point 7.3.3 page 49)
- Students studying Stage 2 and Stage 3 pairs of units can have the grades achieved in each of the units contribute to meeting the WACE requirements. (point 8.3.3 page 59)

Students enrolled in a pair of Stage 2 or Stage 3 units in Year 12 are automatically enrolled to sit the examination in that course. Students enrolled in a pair of Stage 2 **and** Stage 3 units for a course are automatically enrolled in the Stage 3 course examination.

Students who had intended to sit the Stage 2 course examination (instead of Stage 3) must contact the Curriculum Council and request the change in examination enrolment. This request must be made by:

- 7 August 2009 for examinations that have a practical component
- 25 September 2009 for all other examinations.
