The Curriculum Council has commissioned an immediate analysis of enrolment patterns to determine why Year 12 enrolments in 1C and 1D units are higher than anticipated.

A small panel, chaired by the industry representative on Council, will include former principals and educators. Their analysis is planned to be completed by the end of Term 3, 2009.

The panel will look at 2009 enrolment data in new courses and the Year 11 achievements of students in the same course and their other courses. It will involve asking schools to identify why they made certain counselling and timetabling decisions. Parents will be consulted to find out about their experiences and understanding of the counselling process.

Information gathered during the review will help the Council and school sector/systems decide on any minor policy adjustments that may be needed and to help guide schools in their counselling of students into new courses in future years.
