Students who have been prevented from attending an examination, or whose performance has been affected by a temporary sickness, non-permanent disability or unforeseen misadventure suffered immediately before or during the examination period, may wish to submit a sickness/misadventure application. The circumstances must be beyond the usual control of the student.

Application forms are available from all practical and written examination centres, schools or may be downloaded from the Curriculum Council website at http://www.curriculum.wa.edu.au/internet/Senior_Secondary/Exam_Information.

This year application forms will arrive in schools with the personalised examination timetables for candidates.

Applications relating to incidents affecting the practical examination should be submitted immediately following that component of the examination.

For incidents affecting the written examinations in November, students are encouraged to submit their application immediately following their last written examination. The completed form and any supporting documentation must be received by the Curriculum Council no later than 5pm on Friday 27 November 2009.

Candidates will be informed of the outcome of their application at the same time as they receive their statement of results.

Please note, these forms should not be submitted to the Curriculum Council for any matter related to the mock examinations conducted by your school.
