To meet WACE requirements in 2009, students must have covered the 13 overarching learning outcomes in their study program. Subjects, course units and endorsed programs (including VET units of competence) that have been achieved during Year 11 or Year 12 contribute to this breadth of study requirement.

Achievement of a course unit or subject means that all of the assessment requirements have been met and a grade (A – E) has been recorded by the Curriculum Council. Achievement of endorsed programs, including VET units of competence, means that the school has reported to the Curriculum Council the student has met the assessment requirements of that program.

To assist schools to check that their students are able to meet this breadth requirement, a SIRS report has been made available. The pathway to this report is: Report > Other Reports > Report Type: Students > Report: CSE113 – Student Overarching Outcomes.

The report can be generated in two formats – one based on enrolments, the other on achievements.
